Request to be Added to the Permanent Absentee Voter List

I have a recurring reason under current MI election law to receive an absentee ballot and would like to be placed on the permanent absentee voter list: (please check the one which best applies)

- I am 60 years of age or older,
- I expect to be absent from the community in which I am registered for the entire time the polls are open on election day,
- I am physically unable to attend the polls without the assistance of another,
- I cannot attend the polls because of the tenets of my religion,
- I have been appointed an election precinct inspector in a precinct other than the precinct where I reside,
- I cannot attend the polls because I am confined to jail awaiting arraignment or trial.

I understand that the Clerk will send me an application for an absentee ballot 4 to 6 weeks prior to every election for which I am eligible* to vote. I will remain on the list until such time as I am no longer registered to vote in Sherman Township or I request in writing to be removed from the list.

If you wish to vote at the polls, simply do not complete or return the application you receive for that specific election.
