What is an Emergency Repair?

Qualifying repairs may include:

- Repairs to a leaking roof
- Malfunctioning hot water or heating equipment
- Plumbing repairs wherein the house has no running water
- Septic tank is overflowing, or drain field has deteriorated
- Electrical or gas repairs in electrical fire or gas hazard situations, or inability to use necessary major appliances due to faulty electrical wiring
- Structural damage that creates an emergency safety situation
- Emergency handicapped accessibility improvements

Based on the project cost, a Promissory Note and Mortgage resulting in a Lien may be placed against the property.

Program funds are a deferred Loan at 0% interest.

Homeowner Qualifications:

Own and have lived in the home for at least one year;

Property taxes and insurance must be paid and up to date.

The homeowner must meet the following income limits, based on household size:
